**PROSPERITY AG & ENERGY RESOURCES TO HOST SERIES OF FREE REAP GRANT INFORMATIVE
CONFERENCE CALLS**

MONROVIA, Ind. – January 31, 2011 -- Sarah Aubrey, Prosperity Ag and Energy Resources, will host the first free REAP grant conference call on Monday, February 7, 2011 from 3:00 to 5:00 P.M. (EST) with guest speaker Chad Martin, Renewable Energy Extension Specialist, Purdue University. The topic of the call is "Grant Dollars for Eligible Wind Projects". The call will cover details about the types of wind energy projects eligible for grant funding through USDA's Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) Grant, which is available for farmers and rural small businesses. Calls will include time for direct question and answer with experts. The series will run from February to early April and includes additional free conference calls on solar, geothermal, grain dryer replacements, methane digesters, and guaranteed loans. Registration is required. Email erin@prosperityagenergy.com with contact information, and instructions for the call will be provided.

Prosperity's free grant calls will occur every other Monday through April 4, 2011 from 3:00-5:00 P.M. (EST), unless otherwise specified. The schedule is as follows: Wind, February 7th; Solar, February 21st; Guaranteed Loans, March 7th (10:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.); Methane Digester, March 7th; Geothermal, March 21st; Grain Dryer Replacements, April 4th. The REAP grant conference calls are intended to promote the REAP program and provide explanations to anyone interested in the renewable energy and energy efficiency sectors. This is a free, public service and Prosperity encourages everyone interested to participate.

REAP grant funding is authorized through the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (Farm Bill). REAP funding can be used for renewable energy projects, energy efficient improvements, energy audits, feasibility studies and renewable energy development assistance.
